<p align="center"><u>Student entitlement statements</u></p>	<p>Tutors deliver the Student entitlement statement at the start of the first Careers lesson. This statement details Careers information and Learning objectives for the current academic year. It should be used as working document and students should read through after each PSHE lesson to complete the areas they have covered. Some of the objectives may be met in other lessons; these details should also be completed. Tutors ask that students share the document with their parents so that they are aware of the continued Careers Education programme at KSHS.</p>
<p>1.</p> <p align="center"><u>Skills, Subjects and Careers</u></p>	<p>Students will discover, by completing a quiz exercise, what skills they already have and identify those they may need to work on when considering specific areas of work. Students will learn the importance of making the correct GCSE subject choices to ensure they keep all options open to them for the future. Students will also understand how to access their Personal Network of Support at this time.</p>
<p>2.</p> <p align="center"><u>New Kudos</u></p>	<p>New Kudos is a subscribed Web based training programme to assist students at various stages of their Education; starting with GCSE choices it will help students explore possible career directions and assist with learning about their future options.</p>
<p>3.</p> <p align="center"><u>Changes and Transition</u></p>	<p>By completing a number of activities, students will understand when and how they make decisions and look at how these may affect their future career choices. Students will look at influences on choice and good and bad reasons for making decisions and choices.</p>
