**Re: Safe Phased Re-opening**

I wrote to you last week about our intentions to open and set out our safety plan. The date to re-open was to be 8 June, but on 24 May the Prime Minister set the date as 15 June and subsequent DfE guidance confirmed this to be the case. This means that what I set out will commence on 15 June, and we shall send out further detail next week. This face-to face support will supplement the remote learning for Year 10 and Year 12 students in the first instance.

The government will confirm whether schools can re-open when it reviews the position on 28 May. Unless anything different is announced we shall plan for a partial re-opening on 15 June.
