Dear Parents/Guardians

The government advice over the weekend was very clear, and remains so: only send your child to school if you are a key worker and it is absolutely necessary. It seems that people have heeded this advice and today the number of students in both schools in the Trust is very low. Given this we have decided that from Tuesday 24 March we will work together to offer a hub approach to supporting the families of key workers, as well as any identified and agreed vulnerable students who require supervision.

From **Tuesday 24 – Friday 27 March** all Critical Workers children based at either of the schools should report to **Carre's Grammar School** where they will be supervised by staff.

From **Monday 30 March – Friday 3 April** all Critical Workers children based at either of the schools should report to **Kesteven and Sleaford High School** where they will be supervised by staff.

Whilst we encourage students to bring their own food and snacks as well as a water bottle to refill in school, the schools will be doing hot food for students, should it be required. Students should see the catering team at Carre's by 9.00am each morning this week, and the catering team at KSHS the following week. Any student in receipt of Free School Meals will receive a meal at school, whilst all others have previously been notified as to how to access meals from the Sleaford Larder.

We have been made aware of the huge number of people who have been logging onto the network today, and it has caused some problems with accessing files. The IT team has been working on this and has increased resources to return it to full operation. Whilst it is currently working students may continue to experience a short lag and the team will continue to monitor the situation. During the Easter Holidays supervision will be available via the Community Sport Team based at Carre's Grammar School.
