



Expectations of Year 12 Student Behaviour during COVID-19 Partial Reopening

You should:

- maintain a **2 metre** 'social' distance from others whilst moving around school, queuing for wash stations and at all times on the school premises including before lesson, during breaks and in classrooms.
- use the **one-way system** by following the markings in corridors and on landings
- keep away from 'out of bounds areas'
- wait outside before school, maintaining 2 metre social distance, and do not access the buildings until 8.40am. Go directly home when all your lessons are finished
- queue only in the designated places maintaining social distancing at all times
- follow the altered routines when arriving or departing school
- **wash your hands** on entering and leaving the school buildings and where possible upon entering and leaving any classroom. Dry your hands using disposable paper towels.
- **'catch it, bin it, kill it'** when sneezing or coughing:
 - use tissues to capture the cough/sneeze OR if you do not have a tissue, your sleeve
 - place tissue in the bin & wash your hands
 - avoid touching your mouth, nose and eyes with your hands
- **tell an adult** if you are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus and follow their instructions
- **NOT** share any equipment or other items including drinking bottles, pens and pencils, or a personal product such as a lip balm
- stay in the designated area for your group during break times and maintain social distancing of 2 metres. There will be teacher supervision in these areas– if you need to go elsewhere, you **MUST** get permission from an adult first
- use the toilets during break times – maintaining social distancing rules and following the 'one in, one out' principle. There should be no more than 3 people using the toilets at any one time. You will be told the toilet area to use and you should only use this area
- follow new procedures in the event of a fire evacuation and go to the Fire Assembly point ensuring 2 metres social distancing is followed
- **NOT** play sport or ball games on the school site
- bring your mobile devices - laptops, tablets or phones- into school and use these throughout the school day to reduce the need to touch surfaces such as books and paper.
- ensure that your device is fully charged as we cannot allow the charging of devices on school site. You can bring a battery charger to maintain the power of your device. You should not share your mobile device
- bring to school all the food and drink you need throughout the day. Your food and drink cannot be shared with your friends
- carry all your equipment with you at all times
- stay on school site unless you are going home. It is important that you understand you will not be allowed to go to Tesco before, during or at the end of the school day. The same rule applies for other shops in the town, including Gregg's and Sainsburys.
- the normal dress code for sixth form students will be slightly different from normal. We still expect you to be smart, but ties and jackets will not need to be worn. Girls – please note that strappy tops should not be worn and shoulders must be covered. Shorts will not be allowed for any students
- for lessons at SGA you must ensure that you have read and made yourselves familiar with SGA expectations and follow them carefully. You will find a copy of this enclosed with this letter
